PgCert Architecture and Contemporary Practice: Part 3 APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Before accessing the MMU application portal, we have some advice to help your application be processed as efficiently as possible.

- 1. Please make sure you select the correct start date and programme duration. You can select either the **September start (9-month)** programme or the **January start (12-month)** programme.
- 2. To meet the entry criteria for this programme, **you need to be on track to accruing 24-months PPE** (Professional Practical Experience). 12 of the 24 months should be undertaken in the UK or a relevant EU territory and be post Part 2.

ARB practical training requirements:

'... recently completed a minimum of 24 months' practical experience under the direct supervision of a professional working in the construction industry which should include at least 12 months working in a Relevant European Territory, under the direct supervision of an architect.'

In the **Personal Statement** field of the application form, **please include a statement** to confirm that you will be able to demonstrate your 24 months PPE in accordance with ARB requirements, by the time you reach the final assessment.

Final assessment: Professional Interviews are held early June for Sept-start, and mid Dec for Jan-start.

3. Although it is not a requirement for you to do Parts 1, 2 and 3 in any sequential order – if you wish to practice architecture in the UK (using the title 'Architect'), it is a legal requirement that you are listed on the register of architects which is upheld by the ARB.
