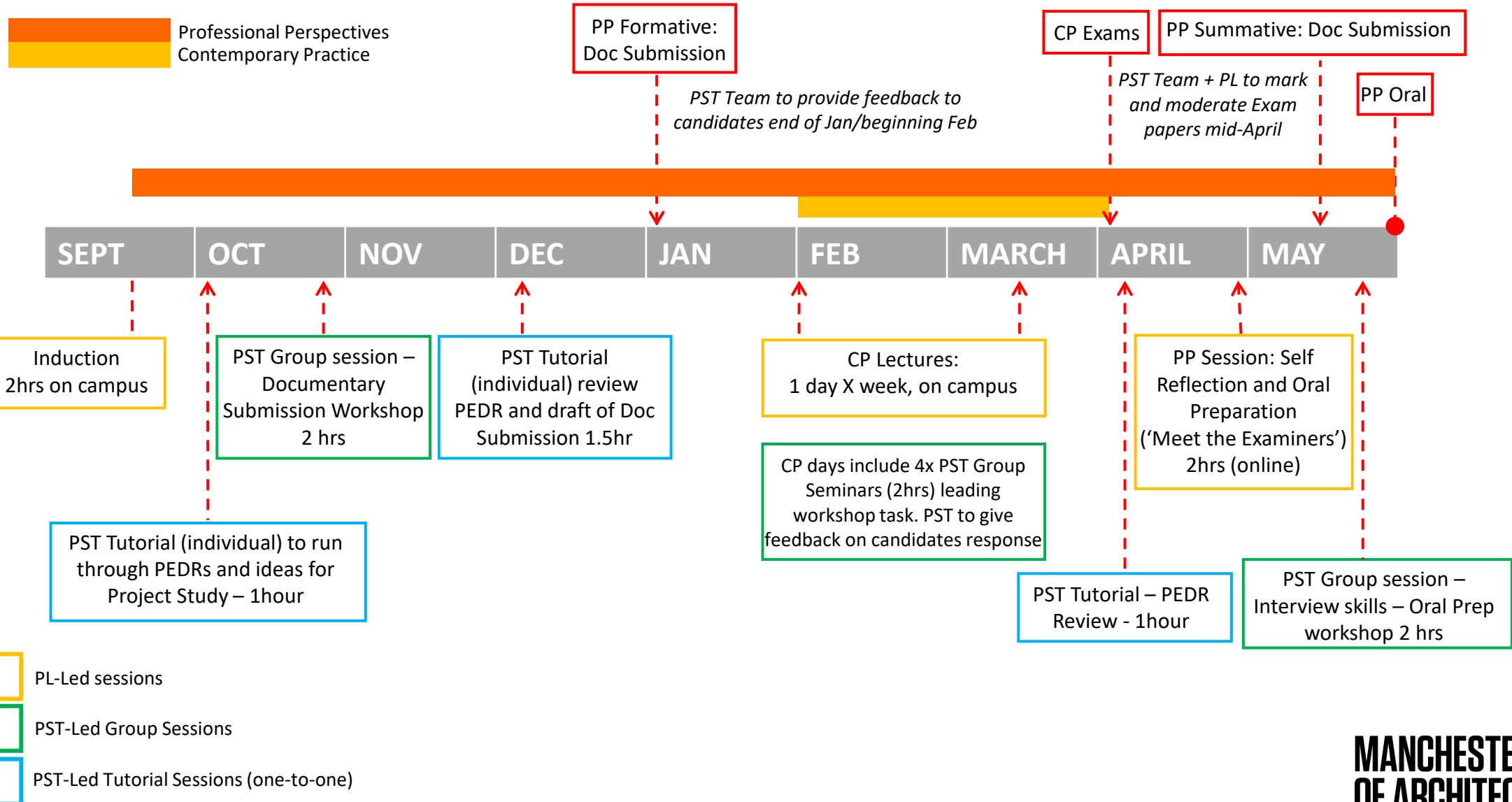
#### Practice Scenario Testing

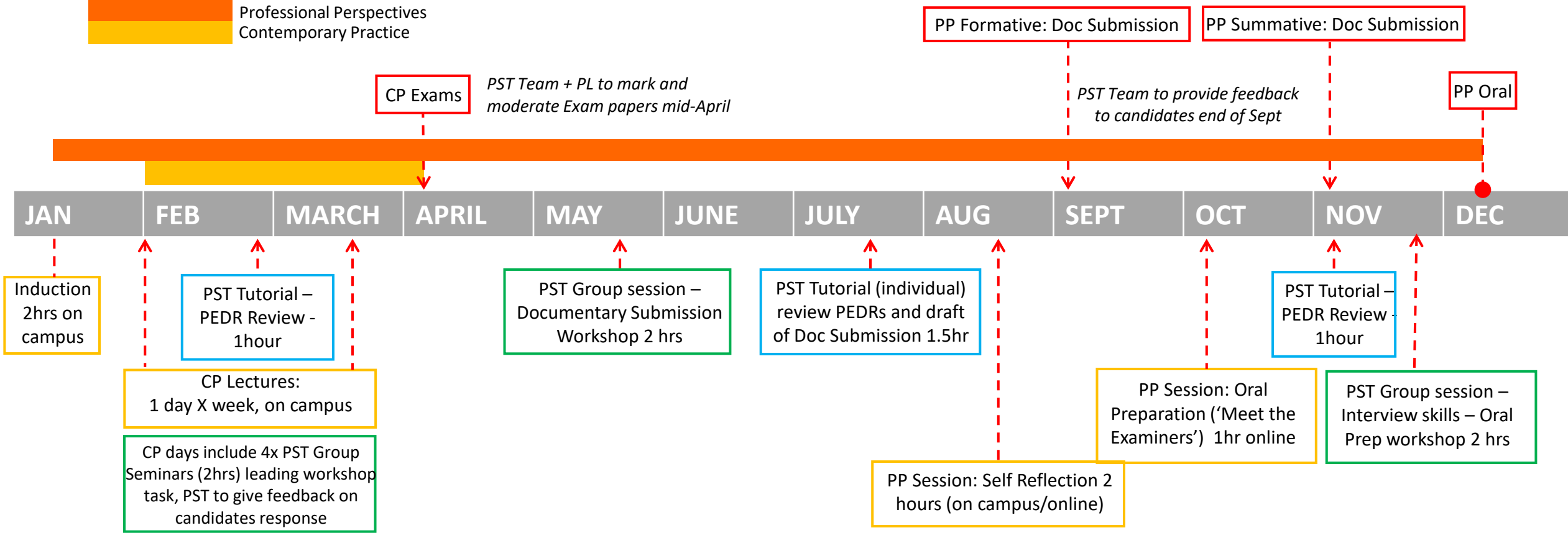
